Farm Interns

Farm interns will help with a range of day-to-day tasks which may include:

- tree planting
- collecting water samples and recording data from our pond,
- mechanical weeding of the pond, and
- fish management
- site clearing and preparation for the nursery,
- high tunnel setup, and
- small solar panel installation.

Restoration Interns

Restoration interns will work on the historic, 1850s cabin on the property. Some of the interns' work may include:

- how to work with horsehair plaster,
- rough and fine carpentry,
- drywall and painting techniques.

Marketing Interns

The Marketing intern will help with social media, assorted outreach projects and occasional events. Strong writing skills are required.

Compensation

These are unpaid internships with the potential for future paid work. Interns will earn exclusive, free access to the property on scheduled days.

Hours

Internships will last 3 months with each intern working 2-3 days per week (Saturday plus 1-2 weekdays).
